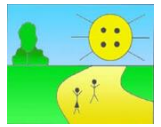

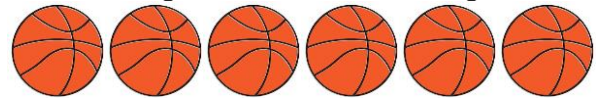


Please do not drive down the school drive at the beginning and end of the day. The car park is just not big enough and there are many children and adults walking on this route.

If we do not receive communication regarding a child's absence it will be recorded in the register as an unauthorised absence. 5 unauthorised register marks can result in a penalty notice being issued by the local authority.
