Thank you for your patience with the refurbishments going on around school.


I am sure you will agree that it will be worth it in the end!

The Key Stage 2 toilets are held up due to the delivery of cubicles. Again, this should be completed within the next 10 days. This rearrangement of the toilets is exciting because it has freed up much needed space to enhance the learning environment. In one area we have created an open block of 14 individual toilets and washrooms and in the other space we are going to create a school library and intervention room. 
#### **Polite Notice**
